MemberDirect 24/7: Access Services on Your Time

Did you know MemberDirect provides you with 24/7 online access to your retirement accounts? Members can securely access their retirement account and information from anywhere, anytime, and on any device.

Through MemberDirect, active COAERS members can obtain benefit estimates, see options for survivor benefits, and view how deductions and insurance will affect retirement take-home pay. Retired COAERS members can easily access their 1099-R forms, review benefit payment details, and view payment history.

Legislative Update: 87th Texas Legislature Session

The regular session of the 87th Texas Legislature concluded on Monday, May 31st. During the biennial session, the state's governing body received several filed bills regarding Texas public retirement systems. One bill of note was House Bill 3898. The bill will amend the Government Code relating to the funding policy and funding soundness restoration plan (FSRP) requirements for public retirement systems and align them with Pension Review Board (PRB)



Pension Funding Guidelines. It would also add new disclosure requirements for investment practices and performance evaluations of retirement systems. H. B. 3898 was approved by the Legislature and has been sent to the Governor. Of the few bills that passed, no legislation runs counter to the Board-adopted legislative priorities.

Last year, the COAERS Board approved a proposal to pursue comprehensive pension reform legislation during the 88th Legislative Session, which is slated to convene in 2023. Leading up to the 2023 legislative session, COAERS and the City will continue to engage in a productive, meaningful, and collaborative effort to develop solutions to improve the retirement system's long-term financial health and sustainability. It is important to note that the retirement system is not in crisis and remains in good financial standing to continue delivering benefits for decades to come. However, as fiduciaries, the COAERS Board takes its responsibility seriously to ensure that every future City employee receives the benefits promised.

We will continue to keep COAERS members well informed of our progress on plan sustainability and work with the City of Austin on potential legislative proposals related to COAERS. To find out more about the Texas Legislature and the 87th Legislative Session, visit www.capitol.state.tx.us.



Plan Fundamentals: Sick Leave

While the primary way to obtain service credit is by working in a regular full-time position and making contributions to the System, you can also establish additional service credit by purchasing it, if you qualify. Sick leave conversion is one of several ways in which you may be able to purchase service credit.

How does it work?

At the time of retirement, you may be able to convert unused sick leave hours to service credit. A sick leave purchase does not make you eligible to retire any sooner, but it will increase your monthly benefit payment. Unused sick leave hours eligible for cash payment may not be converted to service credit. You should start the conversion process 30 to 60 days before your retirement date. You must convert your sick time in 80 hour pay period increments. Both you and the City will pay the current contribution rate at the time of retirement to convert the hours to service credit.

Board News

At the March meeting of the COAERS Board of Trustees, the Board received reports and held discussions about administrative, operational, and investment matters.

During the meeting, the Board approved the results of the December 31, 2020 actuarial valuation. The COAERS consulting actuary reported that the Fund's strong investment returns above the 7% assumed rate of return, in addition to the 1% increase in Clty contributions from 18% to 19% reduced the Plan's funding period from 40 years in 2019 to 32 years. The funding ratio is 65.3% (68.1% on market value of assets), which is up from 63.5% in 2019. While the results show great improvement compared to 2019, the funding period for COAERS is still above the Board's funding policy target. The COAERS Board will continue to work with the City of Austin to implement meaningful solutions for the System's long-term sustainability.

The Board also approved updates to the Investment Policy Statement (IPS) and Investment Implementation Plan (IIP). During the meeting, COAERS Chief Investment Officer David Veal reviewed key changes proposed to the IPS and IIP, which require annual reviews of the risk budget, the strategic asset allocation parameters, performance benchmarks of the Fund and the key policies that govern its management. Additionally, COAERS Executive Director Christopher Hanson presented reports on the updated 2021-2023 Strategic Plan, the administrative budget, and the 87th Legislative Session.

Ready to Retire? Plan ahead with the Retirement Checklist



Making the decision to retire can be an exciting one. Before you can hang up your hat and step into the next chapter of your life, there are several important steps you need to take to complete the retirement process, so remember these tips to help you get started.

Contact COAERS

You can begin the retirement application process 90 days prior to your retirement date. The deadline to apply is the 15th of the month in which you plan on retiring. Before the application window, contact COAERS to speak with a Member Services Specialist who will assist you with the retirement process and review the retirement checklist of required forms and information you'll need to retire. COAERS offers both telephonic and virtual counseling appointments. You can contact our Member Services team at member.services@coaers.org or call (512) 458-2551.

Gather Documents

Begin to gather and make copies of the required documents you'll need to submit with your retirement application. All necessary documents described in the retirement checklist must be submitted to COAERS prior to your effective retirement date. Failure to complete and submit the necessary forms or documents will invalidate your retirement and you may lose benefits as a consequence. The retirement checklist is available on the website at www.coaers.org/Active-Members.

Apply through MemberDirect

You can now apply for retirement online through your MemberDirect account. MemberDirect makes it easy for you to submit your completed retirement application and the required documents to COAERS through the secure online portal. If you don't have a MemberDirect account, register for one at www.coaers.org. Your completed application and forms can also be submitted by mail to the following mailing address:


